Program Components for Girls Ages 13-18

English Language Proficiency

- Interactive online English language course tailored to the academic levels of girls aged 13-18;
- Emphasis on reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills;
- Introduction to foundational concepts in humanities, including history, geography, and social studies;
- Exploration of cultural diversity and societal structures.

Computer Skills

- Basic to intermediate computer literacy training;
- Introduction to essential software and applications.

Basic Science and Mathematics Skills

- Fundamental concepts in science and mathematics tailored to the academic levels of girls aged 13-18;
- Hands-on exercises and real-life applications improve understanding.

Program Components for Women Ages 18+ Interested in Law/Advocacy

English Language Proficiency

- Advanced online English language course focusing on legal terminology and communication skills.

Computer Skills

- Advanced computer literacy training with a focus on legal research tools and software.

Advocacy and Communication Skills

- Training in effective advocacy, public speaking, and interpersonal communication relevant to legal practice.

Business Skills

- Introduction to fundamental business concepts tailored to the legal profession;
- Practical exercises to promote critical thinking and problem-solving in legal contexts.
